# Obituary

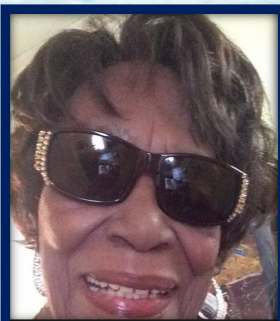
