Mrs. Jones attended Dunbar Elementary School and Jackson High School. After graduating High School (Class of 1964) she worked in the Food Service Department at TJC where she deemed herself a "Chef."

Mrs. Jones would continue to showcase her culinary skills at other fine eateries in the Tyler, Texas area. She was also a small business owner.
